SARR&MC was formed in February, 1983 and incorporated as a non-profit organization in December, 1997. It is a family-oriented, social club that enjoys doing shows with modular displays. The Club does not charge for shows but gratefully accepts honorariums and donations. This is for the fun of it, as well as giving those who love to run trains, but may not have the room at home, the opportunity to do so. The Club also sponsors workshops and how-to clinics. At the current time there are 3 active divisions.

O (Lionel) Division does approximately 15 shows a year, including the Toledo Zoo "Lights Before Christmas" & Metroparks' "Holidays in the Manor House" displays, and many festivals and local county fairs.

HO Division was completely rebuilt recently and is once again doing shows & events such as the Village of Swanton's annual "Christmas in Swanton" day. Its smallest display is 16' x 32'.

N Division operates on a self-contained display that can be wheeled into a show and setup & running in 5 minutes (or less!), running at shows & events along with HO, but also independently.

All 3 do several shows together every year including Sauder Village & National Train Day at Toledo Union Station (Dr. Martin Luther King Plaza).

Currently the membership **dues** are **\$15.00** per year, due before June 1, for an individual or family.

Meeting are usually held the 1st Friday of each month at 8PM at the Swanton Village Hall on Chestnut Street (see map), except April, which is our annual Spouse/Family Appreciation Chili Supper at the Swanton Fire Hall (check the website for any changes).
